

“An Anchor for the Soul”

Steps to sharing and knowing the Gospel

- **Read it.** It's easy. Be reminded of the truth and joy of the gospel.
- **Share it.** Think of a friend(s) who is ready and *consider doing one or more of the following options:*
 - Share a concept or story from the Anchor book...and see where the conversation goes.
 - Give the book (or many books) away and ask them to read it. Follow up with them.
 - Ask someone to go through the book with you using a four-session *discussion guide*.
 - Ask a small group of friends to go through the book with you using the four-session *discussion guide*.

Opportunities to Go Deeper

- **Schedule it.** Consider leading a discussion with a person or group during the four weeks leading up to Easter. This would mean beginning the discussion the week of February 24. (Easter is March 23.).
- **Invite them.** Consider inviting to Easter Sunday worship service anyone with whom you share or discuss the Anchor book.
- **Get help.** Saturday, February 16, 9:30-11:00AM AC and GC. Special training on how to...
 - use the Anchor book
 - bring up spiritual issues
 - talk about gospel truths
 - invite someone to a discussion session (individual/group)
 - guide a discussion group
